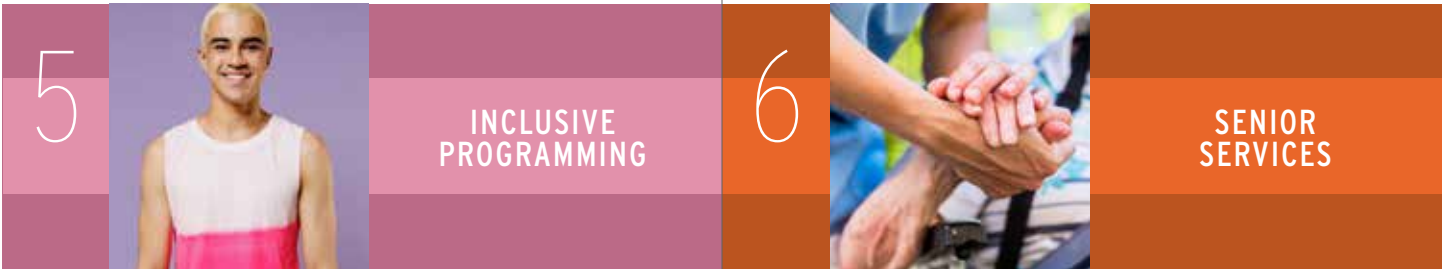

GENERAL SERVICES

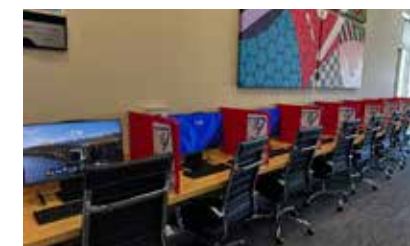
DAVID R. PARKS LENDING LIBRARY

Named by the community in honor of Nevada State Senator David Parks, our LGBTQIA+ focused lending library offers more than 4,000 books and hundreds of DVDs to borrow at no charge.



DAVID BOHNETT CYBERCENTER

Our CyberCenter, recently refreshed by the David Bohnett Foundation with internet service proudly powered by Cox Communications, provides two free hours of computer and internet usage during Center business hours.



THE EVENT CENTER

The Event Center offers a perfect location for any event. You can choose from five different rooms, a combo of rooms, or the whole Event Center. We can accommodate up to 10 – 250 people for an event.



We serve the LGBTQIA+ community as well as the surrounding neighborhoods. **We empower people** with an awareness of their healthcare to enable them to take control of their wellness.

THE ARLENE COOPER COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER



THE ARLENE COOPER COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER

HIV TESTING

We offer free rapid HIV testing with Rapid StART engagement for individuals who test positive or are seeking HIV treatment after transitioning out of care.

STD / STI TESTING

We offer comprehensive services for sexual health, including testing, treatment, and support for syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, and other sexually transmitted infections. For those who test positive, we provide on-site treatment and personalized care.

COUNSELING / RISK ASSESSMENT

Our Clinic staff offers counseling to all clients including navigation of next steps and connecting to Linkage To Care services.

PREP & PEP NAVIGATION

PrEP/PEP navigation is offered to inform clients of preventative options for protection when sexually active. We walk through the process and regimen required for best results.

ON SITE PHARMACY

The Center provides an onsite, full service pharmacy. We serve clinic clients as well as individuals and families from the surrounding area.

TRAC-B

Designated site for this State of Nevada program offering harm reduction tools. Through our vending machine we provide syringe, hormone, first aid, hygiene, and safe sex kits as well as Naloxone and Narcan packs.

Our clinical services provide education, awareness, resources, and referrals to **empower individuals to take charge** of their sexual health and well-being.

HIV SERVICES | EMPOWERLINK

PREVENTION & CARE:

HIV 101

This course provides an overview of essential facts about HIV/AIDS, transmission, prevention, casual contact, testing procedures, state laws and regulations, medications, and services available to Southern Nevada residents living with HIV/AIDS.

LIVING WELL

Living Well is a compassionate life support group for persons living with HIV/AIDS. All HIV-positive individuals are welcome to attend regardless of age, gender, or history of HIV diagnosis.

MED-TIME: TREATMENT & ADHERENCE

Med-Time is an HIV/AIDS health education dinner and learn program that provides an opportunity for people living with HIV to learn about medication options and treatment adherence, as well as meet with a pharmacist one on one to review all of medications.

SAFE SEX KITS

Safe Sex kits are provided to the community to encourage individuals to take charge of their sexual health. Kits include condoms, lube, PEP and PrEP info sheets and information on securing an appointment in the Arlene Cooper Community Health Center.

EMPOWERLINK

The EmpowerLink team assists individuals who engage in substance use that may be harmful and those who are vulnerable to overdose by facilitating opportunities to ensure they are connected to services that will promote harm reduction and safe recovery strategies such as:

- o Resource brokering
- o Harm reduction tools & education
- o Peer support
- o Connection to the community

the center **WELLNESS CLINIC**

THE CENTER WELLNESS CLINIC (CWC) PROVIDES COMPASSIONATE, INCLUSIVE, AND HOLISTIC HEALTHCARE FOR SOUTHERN NEVADA'S LGBTQ+ COMMUNITY AND UNDERSERVED POPULATIONS, ENSURING EQUITABLE ACCESS FOR ALL.

PRIMARY CARE

The Center Wellness Clinic offers inclusive primary care services, specializing in LGBTQ+ and underserved communities, with a focus on prevention, chronic condition management, HIV care, and personalized, culturally competent support.

HIV CARE

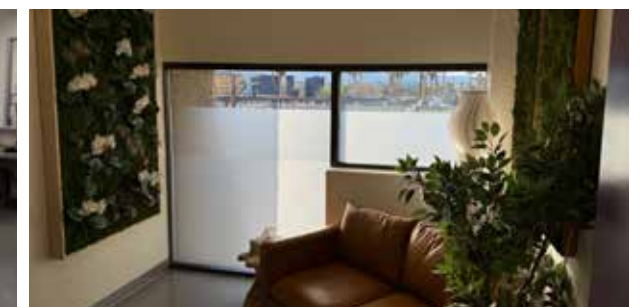
The Center Wellness Clinic provides comprehensive HIV care, including medical treatment, prevention, and support services to ensure holistic health for individuals living with or at risk for HIV by providers who are certified in HIV medicine. Their patient-centered approach emphasizes accessibility, stigma-free care, and community outreach to improve health outcomes.

COMPREHENSIVE REPRODUCTIVE CARE

The Center Wellness Clinic provides inclusive, evidence-based reproductive care for LGBTQIA+ individuals, addressing unique needs, reducing barriers, and fostering a safe, empowering environment.

FAMILY SERVICES

The Center Wellness Clinic's Family Services provide comprehensive adolescent healthcare in a safe, inclusive environment, fostering open communication and empowering teens. We support families by educating them on healthcare topics and strengthening relationships through a welcoming, community-focused approach.



UNINSURED CARE

The Center ensures quality healthcare for all, regardless of ability to pay, supported by grants, community partners, and private donations. We connect patients with resources like insurance navigators and state services to promote long-term health and stability.

PHARMACY SERVICES

The Center Wellness Clinic offers comprehensive pharmacy services to enhance convenience, accessibility, and support for patients and the community. Our in-house and specialty pharmacies provide personalized guidance, co-pay assistance, and streamlined prescription access to improve health outcomes and ensure compassionate, inclusive care.

ACCESSIBLE, QUALITY CARE

Renovation for the Gavin J. Goorjian Community Health Center will begin in early 2025. Through the generous support of the Goorjian Family (\$3.5 million donation), The Helmsley Charitable Trust (\$2.2 million donation) and the Engelstad Foundation (\$2.5 million donation), the new community health center will be the first LGBTQ+ comprehensive medical facility serving Nevada.

By providing primary care services, pharmacy, dental, labs, behavioral health, among other medical services, the Gavin J. Goorjian Community Health Center will become the model for empathetic, high quality, and innovative health care.



We are committed to **closing gaps and barriers** to services through education, advocacy, and partnerships.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

CENTER ADVOCACY NETWORK (CAN)

Our victim advocates provide confidential and non-judgmental support, education, resources, & referrals to on and off campus entities, for victims and their loved ones, following experiences of interpersonal violence. We aid clients with filing a protection order, calling a social service on behalf of a client, helping a family member or partner of a victim/survivor find resources.



COMMUNITY ACCESS & RESOURCE NAVIGATION

We support community members through vital services like SNAP/TANF enrollment assistance, food distribution, and legal aid referrals. Our team is available during open hours to provide compassionate, trauma-informed advocacy and connect individuals with life-sustaining resources.

CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING

The Center's knowledgeable program staff can lead a variety of cultural competency trainings for companies and organizations, on topics such as HIV, gender identity and the LGBTQIA+ community.

COMMUNITY INFORMATION & RESOURCE REFERRALS

Our information and referral desk staff and volunteers happily provide information on topics such as LGBTQIA activities, support groups and organizations as well as referrals to public assistance, counselors, doctors, attorneys, churches and more.

PARTNER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Assistance with applications and processing for those in need. These services are in partnership with Three Square and the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services.

SHOWER TRUCK FRIDAYS

Clean the World shower truck offers free showers in the eastside parking lot.

The Center honors and respects the diversity of bodies, genders and relationships. Our **inclusive programming** seeks to **support the communities we serve**, both holistically and individually by offering peer groups, referrals and resources, outreach and events wherever there is need.



GENDER TRANSLATIONS

Gender Translations is a peer-led support group designed for transgender and non-binary individuals to build community, share experiences, and access affirming resources. The group fosters a sense of belonging through weekly meetings, collaborative activities, and group participation in local events.

NAME & GENDER MARKER CHANGE WORKSHOP

Assistance filling out applications for name and gender marker changes for gender identity! We partner with Nevada Legal Services to assist our clients with this process.

BLACK LGBTQ GROUP

This peer-led social support group offers a dedicated space for members of the Black LGBTQ community to connect, share experiences, and engage in meaningful dialogue. The group meets regularly to discuss topics relevant to their lives, including current events, identity, culture, and community issues.

GUY TALK

Guy Talk is a peer-led support group created specifically for transgender men and AFAB (assigned female at birth) individuals exploring transmasculine identity. The group provides a space for participants to connect, share experiences, and build community through open and affirming conversation. Centered on fostering brotherhood and authentic self-expression, Guy Talk supports participants in navigating identity, relationships, and personal growth while creating lasting bonds within the transmasculine community.

L GROUP

L Group is a weekly support and social group for women, with a focus on creating space for the lesbian community. The group offers a relaxed and welcoming environment where participants can engage in meaningful conversation, share experiences, and build connections. By fostering community and mutual support, L Group plays an important role in reducing isolation and affirming the diverse identities and experiences of LGBTQIA+ women.

Our programs and services **provide education, awareness, referrals, and resources** that assist the individual in **becoming self-sufficient** and have an active role in their own wellness and well-being.

SENIOR SERVICES

MEN'S MONDAY GAME DAY

Men's Monday Game Day provides gay and bisexual men aged 50 and older with a relaxed and welcoming space to connect through games and conversation. Participants enjoy classics like canasta, Mexican dominoes, and Scrabble, while building friendships and fostering community among peers in a supportive environment.

WIZE WOMYN'S WEDNESDAYS

Wize Womyn's Wednesdays provide a consistent and affirming space for lesbians aged 50 and older to connect, unwind, and build community. Each week features a different activity designed to foster engagement and joy—ranging from lesbian-themed movie days and game afternoons to creative arts projects and lively Bingo with prizes. The program promotes social connection, creativity, and a strong sense of belonging among older LGBTQIA+ women..

INCLUSIVE THURSDAYS

Inclusive Thursdays support LGBTQIA+ adults aged 50 and older through weekly opportunities for learning, connection, and community. The program features a Lunch & Learn series with invited speakers presenting on topics such as local history, health and wellness, and community resources. Each session concludes with a free lunch provided by The Center, creating space for social engagement, conversation, and support in an affirming environment.

We celebrate the **diversity, courage and tenacity** of our youth and are privileged to offer space and support for their personal growth as they develop into their **authentic identities**.



PIVOT

Pivot is a six-week program designed to support LGBTQIA+ youth and their caregivers as they navigate identity, communication, and family dynamics. Through guided sessions, participants engage in meaningful conversations, receive affirming resources, and develop tools to strengthen relationships. We aim to keep families together.



QVOLUTION

qVolution is designed to meet the mental, social, and developmental needs of LGBTQIA+ and ally youth ages 13-17. We're working to prepare our youth for the world and prepare the world for our youth! Youth Activity Nights are supportive, educational, and fun!

COMPREHENSIVE SEX ED

Youth ages 13 to 18 can receive free sex education classes that cover contraception, consent, identity formation, and understanding of HIV/STI prevention. It features the core values of abstinence, protection, and pregnancy prevention in an LGBTQIA+ inclusive and gender-neutral environment.

QKIDS

QKids is a monthly program for LGBTQ+ children aged 12 and under and their families, offering a playful, inclusive space for kids to express themselves while caregivers connect, share experiences, and access peer support and resources.

YOUTH AND FAMILY THERAPEUTIC SUPPORT GROUPS

Held monthly, these therapeutic support groups provide LGBTQ+ youth and their families with a safe, affirming space to grow together. Youth meet with a licensed therapist to explore identity and build resilience, while parents and caregivers receive peer support to navigate their journey and care for their own well-being.

YOUTH EVENTS

YOUTH PROM is an annual celebration that offers LGBTQIA+ youth a joyful and affirming space to dress up, bring a significant other, and enjoy an evening of dancing, connection, and celebration. More than just a dance, this free event allows youth to express their authentic selves in a safe, supportive environment surrounded by peers who celebrate them.

YOUTH THANKSGIVING is a seasonal gathering that welcomes LGBTQIA+ youth, their families, and friends to enjoy a free holiday meal at The Center. The event creates a warm, inclusive space to connect, share gratitude, and experience community during a time when many need it most. For some, it offers a rare opportunity to celebrate the season as their full, authentic selves.

We are **proud of our volunteers** who help us deliver our programs and services every day. Last year 227 volunteers performed over 22,000 hours of service in 32 different areas.



VOLUNTEERS

INFORMATION DESK

Our volunteers operate the information desk on a day-to-day basis. They welcome guests, provide information, operate the CyberCenter, and maintain our library. As the first point of contact to The Center they play an important role in our success.

PROGRAM ASSISTANCE

Center volunteers support the delivery of programs and services throughout the year. They provide administrative assistance, group support, and facilitation.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Center events offer another opportunity for volunteers to be involved. Volunteers assist with planning, event set-up, and management.

GIVE BACK DAYS

The Center hosts many local organizations throughout the year that have designated days to give back to the community. Through these events individual learn about The Center, our services, and our community.

BASIC NEEDS & SEASONAL SUPPORT

We provide a range of essential items to help meet the immediate needs of our community. Year-round, we distribute hygiene kits, menstruation kits, pet food for dogs and cats, and shelf-stable groceries. During the colder months, we also provide blankets, hand warmers, socks, and gloves to help individuals experiencing housing insecurity stay warm and safe.

The Center is dedicated to supporting those in our community who are in need. We provide **safe and non-judgmental spaces** for recovery groups to meet.



COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES

RECOVERY SUPPORT GROUPS

ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS (AA)

Is a 12-Step program/fellowship of people who come together to solve their drinking problem. Membership is open to anyone who wants to do something about their drinking problem.

CRYSTAL METH ANONYMOUS

Is a 12-Step program/fellowship of people who share their experience, strength, and hope with each other. The only requirement is the desire to stay sober.

SEX & LOVE ADDICTS ANONYMOUS

Is a 12-step program for people recovering from sex and love addiction.

SMART RECOVERY

(Self-Management And Recovery Training) is a program that assists individuals seeking abstinence from addiction. The non-12-step program teaches you how to change self-defeating thinking and emotions to improve your quality of life.

The Center offers a **safe space for other LGBTQIA+** community organizations to gather. Our goal is to make sure the individual has the resources they need to **live their authentic lives.**

COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES

COMMUNITY GROUPS

ACES & AROS

Aces & Aros is a supportive discussion group for asexual, aromantic, and questioning individuals. The group offers a safe, affirming space to share experiences, build community, and explore identity through peer connection and education. Participants engage in open dialogue while fostering greater understanding and visibility within the broader LGBTQIA+ community.

SNAPIQS

The Southern Nevada API Queer Society (SNAPIQS) serves the Asian, Pacific Islander, Desi American community through raising awareness on LGBTQ issues and hosting educational, social, and cultural events.

POLYAMORY GROUP

Discuss polyamorous relationships (ethical non-monogamy involving emotionally intimate relationships with the knowledge and consent of multiple partners).

SOMOS UNIDOS

A social and educational support group for the Latinx LGBTQIA+ community. (En Español)

BI/PANSEXUAL DISCUSSION GROUP

A space for bisexual and pansexual people to discuss topics of coming out, representation in the media, agency, erasure, isolation, gender dynamics and paradigms, and the nature of gendered attractions and more.

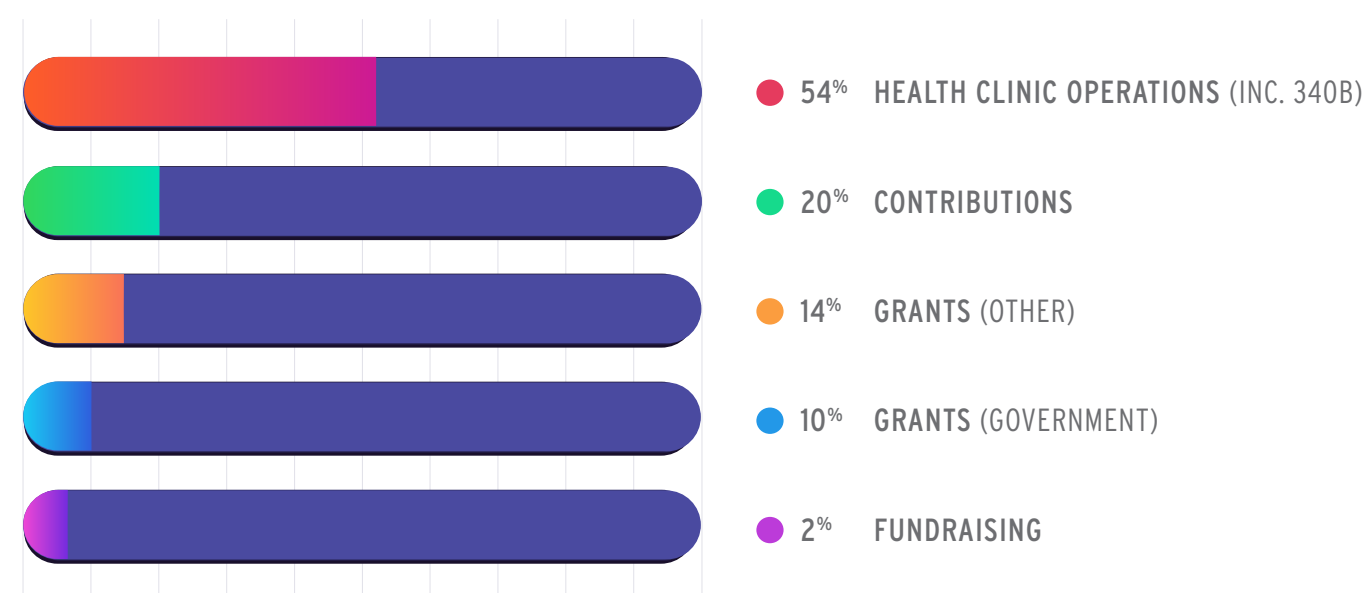
GAY MEN'S FORUM

Designed to provide a safe, confidential, respectful, and supportive environment for the open intelligent exchange of topics and ideas of interest to our community and the world at large.

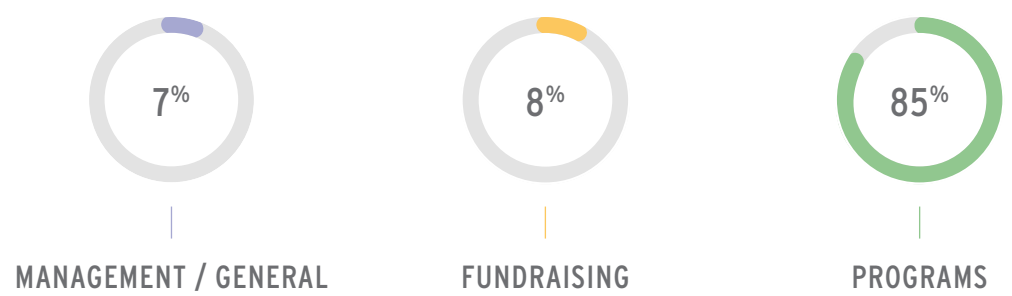

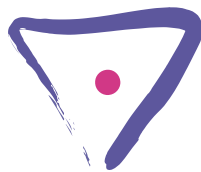
